



## RESOLUTION 2004-058

### A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A DESIGN CONTRACT WITH WALLIS ENGINEERING FOR DESIGN OF UPPER PINE STREET

**WHEREAS**, Upper Pine Street from Willamette to Sunset becomes a collector street under the proposed Transportation System Plan and the Downtown Streetscape Master Plan;

**WHEREAS**, Upper Pine Street, which is currently a substandard street, must be redesigned to adequately serve as a collector;

**WHEREAS**, the firm Wallis Engineering was selected through a consultant selection process meeting the requirements of the State contract rules;

**WHEREAS**, staff and the consultant are working together to develop a scope of work, budget, and schedule for the project; and


**WHEREAS**, the anticipated design cost of this project, including design contingency is expected to be under \$875,000.

### **NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The City Manager is authorized to enter into a design contract with Wallis Engineering for design of Upper Pine Street for an amount not to exceed \$875,000.

**Section 2.** This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
