

RESOLUTION 2004-058

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A DESIGN CONTRACT WITH WALLIS ENGINEERING FOR DESIGN OF UPPER PINE STREET

WHEREAS, Upper Pine Street from Willamette to Sunset becomes a collector street under the proposed Transportation System Plan and the Downtown Streetscape Master Plan;

WHEREAS, Upper Pine Street, which is currently a substandard street, must be redesigned to adequately serve as a collector;

WHEREAS, the firm Wallis Engineering was selected through a consultant selection process meeting the requirements of the State contract rules;

WHEREAS, staff and the consultant are working together to develop a scope of work, budget, and schedule for the project; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated design cost of this project, including design contingency is expected to be under \$875,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a design contract with Wallis Engineering for design of Upper Pine Street for an amount not to exceed \$875,000.

<u>Section 2</u>. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
