



RESOLUTION 2004-059

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A DESIGN CONTRACT WITH HOPPER, DENNIS, JELLISON, P.L.L.C. FOR DESIGN OF ADAMS AVENUE AND OREGON STREET

WHEREAS, the City's Transportation Plan calls for construction of Adams Avenue;

WHEREAS, the firm Hopper, Dennis, Jellison, P.L.L.C. was selected through a consultant selection process meeting the requirements of the State contract rules;

WHEREAS, staff and the consultant are working together to develop a scope of work, budget, and schedule for the project; and


WHEREAS, the anticipated design cost of this project, including design contingency is expected to be under \$900,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a design contract with Hopper, Dennis, Jellison, P.L.L.C. for design of the Adams Avenue (Tualatin-Sherwood Road to Ash) and Oregon Street (Lincoln to Cannery) for an amount not to exceed \$900,000.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
