

Resolution 2004-064

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH FD THOMAS, INC FOR THE SNYDER WATER TANK MAINTENANCE AND UPGRADE PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Project is contained in the city's Maintenance Work Program; and

WHEREAS, city staff utilized a public bidding process for this project meeting the requirements of the city and state contract rules; and

WHEREAS, FD Thomas, Inc submitted the low bid in the amount of \$115,560.00, which consists of all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to complete the work; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends establishing a construction contingency of 15% of the bid, an amount of \$17,334.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The contract is awarded to FD Thomas, Inc for the bid amount of \$115,560.00 for the Snyder Water Tank Maintenance and Upgrade project.

Section 2: The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with FD Thomas, Inc in an amount of \$115,560.00 for the Snyder Water Tank Maintenance and Upgrade project.

Section 3: The Council approves a construction contingency of \$17,334.00.

Section 4: Subject to the limitations of the City's Local Contract Review Board Rules and other applicable laws, the City Manager is authorized to enter into change orders with FD Thomas, Inc or enter into contracts with other contractors for services related to the construction of the Snyder Water Tank Maintenance and Upgrade in the amount not to exceed \$17,334.00

Section 5: This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
