A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FORMATION OF THE CANNERY SITE CONCEPTUAL PLANNING (CSCP) COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the City is purchasing the 6.2 acre site in Old Town known as the Cannery Property; and

WHEREAS, the City intends to have that property redeveloped; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to encourage public input on how the Cannery Site should be redeveloped;


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor shall appoint a member from every City advisory and standing committee to the CSCP; the term will be no longer than 90 days without Mayor Reappointment. This committee will be co-chaired by the Sherwood Urban Renewal Planning and Advisory Committee Council liaison and the Mayor.

Section 2: The CSCP will be charged with the creation of a needs definition statement for the Conceptual Design of the Cannery site.


Section 3: The CSCP will have a \$10,000 dollar budget that will be used to facilitate meetings with the public and other incidental costs associated with accomplishing their charge.
