A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FORMATION OF THE AREA 59 CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Metro Council expanded the UGB in 2002; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to develop a concept plan per Title 11 of the Metro Code; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to encourage public input on how the area should be redeveloped;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor shall appoint a member from every City advisory and standing committee to the Area 59 CAC; the term will be no longer then 1 year with out Mayor Reappointment. This committee will be co-chaired by the Sherwood Planning Commission and City Council liaison.

Section 2: The Area 59 Citizens Advisory Committee will be charged with providing recommendations on the creation of a concept plan.

<u>Section 3:</u> The Area 59 Citizens Advisory Committee will have a \$10,000 dollar budget that will be used to facilitate meetings with the public, develop technical analysis and findings, and offset other incidental costs associated with accomplishing their charge.
