

Resolution 2004-101

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING FINDINGS IN SUPPORT OF A REGIONAL MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM (MS4) PERMIT RENEWAL.

WHEREAS, the City is a local jurisdiction in Washington County and actively works with the Clean Water Services District to effectively manage stormwater; and

WHEREAS, the city has adopted a Stormwater Management Master Plan (Ordinance No. 93-972) that is referenced in the acknowledged Sherwood Community Development Plan; and

WHEREAS, the land use policies, implementations strategies, and zoning code is consistent with the Regional Surface Water Master Plan, and meets the requirements under OAR 340-018-0050(2)(b) as described in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City supports the efforts of Clean Water Services to manage stormwater on a watershed basis to improve water quality, flood capacity, and fish and wildlife habitat.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: The Planning Supervisor is authorized to sign a Land Use Compatibility Statement (LUCS) and submit said form to the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) via Clean Water Services District.

Section 2: Exhibit A attached hereto is hereby approved and adopted.

Section 3: This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
