



**Resolution 2005-007**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A SETTLEMENT WITH DLR GROUP ARCHITECTS RELATIVE TO THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE SHERWOOD POLICE FACILITY FIRING RANGE**

**WHEREAS**, the City entered into settlement discussions with DLR Architects relative to concerns the City had about the construction of the Police Firing Range in the Sherwood Police Facility;


**WHEREAS**, DLR has made an offer to the City to settle the controversy through the payment of \$18,000.00 to the City by DLR and the City Council, on the advice of the City Attorney and consulting special counsel believes it in the City's best interests to accept said settlement offer

**NOW THEREFORE**, based on the foregoing, the City Council for the City of Sherwood resolves as follows:

**Section 1.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a settlement agreement (in a form approved by the City Attorney or outside consulting counsel, Charles R. Schrader) with DLR Group Architects which settlement shall provide for the payment to the City of a sum not less than \$18,000.00.

**Section 2.** This resolution is and shall be effective from and after its passage by the Council.
