



Resolution 2005-009

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PORTLAND AND WESTERN RAILROAD FOR THE DESIGN TO RELOCATE THE RAILROAD SIDING FROM DOWNTOWN TO A LOCATION BETWEEN TUALATIN-SHERWOOD ROAD AND CIPOLE ROAD

WHEREAS, the City wishes to relocate the railroad crossing currently in Old Town to prepare for the Downtown Streetscape Project; and

WHEREAS, the City has an opportunity, through Portland and Western Railroad, to provide design services to prepare the construction package; and

WHEREAS, this opportunity provides cost savings and reduces coordination time to obtain the complete construction package; and

WHEREAS, Portland and Western Railroad has provided a reasonable project estimate of \$40,765.00; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends establishing a contingency of 15% of the project estimate, an amount of \$6,000.00.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Portland and Western Railroad for the project estimate of \$40,765.00,


Section 2: Council approves a contingency of \$6,000.00. Subject to the limitation of the City's Local Contract Review Board Rules and other applicable laws, the City Manager is authorized to enter into change orders with Portland and Western Railroad or other contractors for services related to the design of the siding relocation in the amount not to exceed \$6,000.00

Section 3: This resolution is and shall be effective from and after its passage by the Council.
