A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE CITY OF SHERWOOD POLICE DEPARTMENT'S INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE PORTLAND BUREAU OF POLICE FOR ACCESS TO THE PORTLAND POLICE DATA SYSTEM (PPDS)

WHEREAS, currently the City of Sherwood has no data system for report storage or retrieval; and

WHEREAS, all the cities in Washington County are converting to the Portland Police Bureau's data system for report storage and retention; and

WHEREAS, the link to the City of Portland's system allows the Sherwood Police access numerous data base systems throughout Washington and Multnomah County; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager, having advised Council in the past about the upcoming upgrade, authorized the Police Chief to begin processing the intergovernmental agreement in order to bring Sherwood on line on schedule with other cities in Washington County.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Council hereby ratifies the intergovernmental agreement with the Portland Police to allow Sherwood Police access to the Portland Police Data System (PPDS)

Section 2: This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
