



Resolution 2005-029

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE
BROOKMAN ADDITION CONCEPT PLAN**

WHEREAS, Metro brought Area 54-55 (Brookman Road) into the regional urban growth boundary (UGB) in 2002; and

WHEREAS, City staff is applying for a Transportation and Growth Management (TGM) grant due on May 23, 2005 to fund the Brookman Addition Concept Plan that will meet Metro's Title 11 requirements of the Urban Growth Management Functional Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City is committing in-kind services, such as staff time, to match 15 percent of the overall \$150,000 estimated budget; and

WHEREAS, the grant application requires a demonstration of support from local elected officials and partner agencies, and city staff has solicited letters of support from Raindrops to Refuge, Metro, and Washington County; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has identified the task in the 2005 Work Program and endorsed the grant application on April 26, 2005; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission and City Council recognize the benefits of a coordinated plan for land use and transportation, and acknowledge the need for a planned I-5/99W Connector south of the proposed study area.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The Brookman Addition Concept Plan application is endorsed and the Planning Supervisor shall execute the submittal of the application by May 23, 2005.
