

Resolution 2005-030

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE QUARRY AREA CONCEPT PLAN

WHEREAS, Metro brought the "Quarry Area" into the regional urban growth boundary (UGB) in 2004 (Metro Ordinance No. 2004-104B); and

WHEREAS, City staff is jointly applying for a Transportation and Growth Management (TGM) grant with the City of Tualatin to fund the Quarry Area Concept Plan that will meet Metro's Title 11 requirements of the Urban Growth Management Functional Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City is committing in-kind services, such as staff time, to match 15 percent of the overall budget; and

WHEREAS, the grant application requires a demonstration of support from local elected officials and partner agencies, and the City of Tualatin and the City of Sherwood are cooperating consistent with Resolution No. 2002-051; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission and City Council recognize the benefits of a coordinated plan for land use and transportation, and acknowledge the need for a planned regional Tonquin Trail near the study area.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

The Quarry Area Concept Plan application is endorsed and the Planning Supervisor shall execute the submittal of the application jointly with the City of Tualatin by May 23, 2005.
