

Resolution No. 2005-068

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A LOCAL MATCHING GRANT TO METRO FOR THE TONQUIN CREEK TRAIL

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood was awarded a federal transportation (ISTEA) grant of \$88,000 in 1992 toward the Cedar Creek greenway trail project, which included a 10.27% match from the city;

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood did not design or build a project to receive those funds;

WHEREAS, the City could offer those funds, which would otherwise revert to the federal government through ODOT, to assist in the completion of the Tonquin Trail master plan; and

WHEREAS, the Tonquin Trail is a planned, regional, multi-use path as adopted in the Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) and Sherwood Transportation System Plan (TSP) that will eventually connect three cities: Tualatin, Sherwood, and Wilsonville;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. To contribute a required local match of \$9,200 of General Fund monies through METRO to complete the Tonquin Trail.

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to allocate and transfer said monies and participate in a regional partnership between METRO, on the condition that Wilsonville and Tualatin contribute a proportional match.
