**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A CODE ASSISTANCE APPLICATION FOR
THE CREATION OF INFILL STANDARDS IN THE SHERWOOD ZONING
AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CODE**

WHEREAS, The City of Sherwood currently has no infill development standards in the Sherwood Zoning and Community Development Code;

WHEREAS, City staff is applying to the Oregon Transportation and Growth Management (TGM) Smart Development Code Assistance program that requires no local cash match;

WHEREAS, the City is committed to assist with in-kind services such as logistical support research, evaluation, and project management;

WHEREAS, the technical assistance application requires a demonstration of support from local decision-makers;

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has identified the task in the 2005 Work Program; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission and City Council recognize the benefits of infill standards to improving neighborhood design and connectivity, and acknowledge the need for assistance in developing this section of the Development Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The Infill Standards Code Assistance application (Exhibit A) is endorsed and the Associate Planner (Project Manager) shall execute the submittal of the application.
