A RESOLUTION TO REPEAL RESOLUTION 2001-962, A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A COUNCIL POLICY (#1) – PUBLIC CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY IN OLD TOWN SHERWOOD DURING THE THANKSGIVING THROUGH NEW YEAR HOLIDAY SEASON

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the time between Thanksgiving and New Years is a critical period for retailers in Old Town Sherwood. The policy of the Council of Sherwood as expressed in Resolution 2001-962 is to suspend public construction projects affecting street/sidewalk area in any retail district between Thanksgiving and New Years each year wherever possible;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City to maintain a thriving and vibrant Old Town;

WHEREAS, there is a need to permit construction in retail districts during the holiday season.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Resolution 2001-962 is hereby repealed.

Section 2: It is understood that construction work may be undertaken in retail districts within the City. If work is undertaken during the holiday season, then appropriate parking, signage to MUTCD standards as a minimum and safe pedestrian access to the area as well as individual business operations shall be maintained. Communication and coordination with effected businesses will be maintained.


Section 3: This resolution is and shall be effective from and after its passage by the Council.
