

## Resolution 2005-076

**GRANTING** RESOLUTION CITY MANAGER AUTHORITY TO APPROPRIATE CITY DEVELOPMENT AND CONSTRUCTION FEES AND USE PUBLIC OUTREACH FUNDS TO OFFSET STATE REQUIRED BULDING PERMIT FEES FOR THE JASON REHLING FAMILY HOME.

WHEREAS, Jason Rehling, a Grant County Sheriff's Deputy, was dramatically injured in the line of duty on May 3, 2003;

WHEREAS, the injuries sustained by Deputy Rehling on May 3, 2003, preclude him from resuming his vocation as a County Deputy:

WHEREAS, a broad coalition of individuals, groups, businesses, and memorial funds have joined together to build a home for the Jason Rehling family;

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood was selected as the location to build the Rehling family home; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood desires to welcome the Rehling family and contribute to the successful community effort to construct the Rehling family home.

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized to waive the appropriate City of Sherwood portion of development and construction related fees (such as, but not limited to: water, sanitary sewer, storm, and park system development fees) for the Rehling family home.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to use public outreach funds to offset required State building fees for the Rehling family home.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
