



**Resolution 2006-016**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PROPOSED NOVEMBER BOND MEASURE  
SUBMITTED BY METRO TO PURCHASE GREENSPACES IN THE METRO REGION**

**WHEREAS**, the City is a member of Metro;

**WHEREAS**, Metro is proposing to include a ballot measure in the election of November 2006 asking for a tax to be levied on all citizens in their member communities;

**WHEREAS**, this proposed tax will support the purchase of open spaces in the Metro region;

**WHEREAS**, Raindrops to Refuge (R2R) has asked the City Council to support this proposed measure.


**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** By way of this resolution the Sherwood City Council does hereby declare its support of the proposed 2006 Metro Bond Measure to purchase open spaces in the Metro region.

**Section 2.** The Sherwood City Council recommends the return of revenues to local jurisdictions on a net asset, or assessed valuation basis rather than a per capita basis.

**Section 3.** This resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
