A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE SHERWOOD SCHOOL DISTRICT BALLOT MEASURE 34-130

WHEREAS, Sherwood is a young community with a significant number of its families having school aged children; and

WHEREAS, Sherwood schools are at capacity with the elementary schools and middle school currently beyond capacity; and

WHEREAS, Sherwood City officials have seen a tremendous amount of growth within the last 10 years and want to prepare for the future of Sherwood and its community members; and


WHEREAS, the City wants to express its support of Ballot Measure 34-130 this November and call upon the members of the Sherwood community to do the same.
