



Resolution 2006-060

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MURRAY, SMITH & ASSOCIATES FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A SANITARY SYSTEM MASTER PLAN

WHEREAS, the Sanitary System Master Plan is contained in the city's Capital Improvement Plan; and

WHEREAS, City staff utilized a consultant selection process for this project meeting the requirements of the City and State contract rules; and

WHEREAS, the most qualified firm was selected through this process to develop the Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated design cost of this project is \$156,000; and the City Engineer recommends a design contingency of 20% (\$31,200) to cover unanticipated development costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Murray, Smith & Associates for development of the Sanitary System Master Plan project for an amount not to exceed \$187,200.

Section 2: This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
