Resolution 2006-061

A RESOLUTION REQUIRING ALL PERSONS DESIRING TO WORK IN PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY TO OBTAIN A PERMIT ISSUED BY THE CITY PRIOR TO BEGINNING WORK

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood wishes to maintain the quality and integrity of the existing roads and streets constructed within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has developed and established construction standards to insure the quality of the construction and the installed facilities; and

WHEREAS, from time to time it becomes necessary to install or connect to utilities within or across the existing street areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1:</u> The City Engineer is authorized to establish and maintain Right-of-Way Permits, conditions and standards necessary to insure that all work performed in the public right of way is conducted in a manner that minimizes disturbance to the public, controls quality of the repairs and otherwise protects the public interest.

Section 2: Resolution 93-567 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 3: This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
