



RESOLUTION 2006-067

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MURRAY, SMITH & ASSOCIATES FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE STORMWATER MASTER PLAN

WHEREAS, the Stormwater Master Plan was listed in the City's FY 2005-2006 Capital Improvement Plan; and

WHEREAS, Staff deferred work on the master plan forward to this fiscal year because of the construction and development workload; and

WHEREAS, city staff utilized a consultant selection process for this project meeting the requirements of the city and state contract rules; and

WHEREAS, the most qualified firm was selected through this process to develop the master plan; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated design cost of this project is \$198,400; and the City Engineer recommends a design contingency of 20% (\$20,000) to cover unanticipated costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Murray, Smith & Associates for development of the Stormwater Master Plan project for an amount not to exceed \$216,400.

Section 2: This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
