



RESOLUTION 2007-054

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MURRAY SMITH & ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR THE WATER SUPPLY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City wishes to develop a new source of potable water supply to the City from the Willamette River; and

WHEREAS, City staff utilized a consultant selection process for this project meeting the requirements of the City and State contract rules; and

WHEREAS, the most qualified firm was selected through this process for final design and construction management of the Water Supply Improvements project; and

WHEREAS, Murray Smith and Associates, Inc. has provide a reasonable project estimate in the amount of \$2,370,282.00; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends establishing a contingency of 15% of the project estimate, an amount of \$355,545.00.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Murray Smith & Associates, Inc. for final design and construction management of the Water Supply Improvements project estimate of \$2,370,282.00


Section 2. Council approves a contingency of \$355,545.00. Subject to limitation of the City's Local Contract Review Board Rules and other applicable laws, the City Manager is authorized to enter into change orders with Murray, Smith & Associates, Inc.
