## RESOLUTION 2008-005

### A RESOLUTION REQUESTING STAFF TO BRING A PARKS BOND BALLOT TITLE TO COUNCIL FOR CONSIDERATION

**WHEREAS**, In October 2006 the Sherwood City Council adopted the Parks Master Plan submitted for consideration by the Parks Advisory Board; and

**WHEREAS**, The Parks Advisory Board has reviewed that Master Plan and submitted their top priorities for construction to City Council based on the plan; and

**WHEREAS**, Staff has created preliminary construction costs to build the projects proposed by the Parks Advisory Board and further indicated that there is a gap of \$6 million to complete that list;

#### **NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

To instruct the City Manager to;


**Section 1:** Bring a ballot title for a bond measure asking the Citizens to consider a \$6 million General Obligation Bond; and
