



RESOLUTION 2009-019

A RESOLUTION SETTING A SURCHARGE FOR SANITARY AND STORM WATER UTILITY USE AND REPEALING RELATED SECTIONS OF THE FEE SCHEDULE SET FORTH IN RESOLUTION 2008-043

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood Sanitary and Storm Utility Funds are primarily dependent upon sanitary and storm rate revenues for funding; and

WHEREAS, the Sherwood Municipal Code (SMC 2.32.010) authorizes certain administrative fees and charges to be established by Resolution of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood Budget and Capital Plan requires both direct expenditure and the issuance of debt to provide for the maintenance, design and construction of the Sanitary and Storm Utility Enterprises; and

WHEREAS, a monthly sewer and storm utility user charge for property within the City that is served by Clean Water Services (CWS) of Washington County is adopted annually by CWS, and

WHEREAS, The City of Sherwood adds a surcharge to the CWS fee to fund services provided by the City, including both direct expenditures and debt service; and

WHEREAS, a Sanitary Utility rate surcharge of \$5.75 and a Storm Utility rate surcharge of \$10.71 per Equivalent Dwelling Unit per month is necessary to generate sufficient revenue to meet anticipated capital expenses, debt service payments and coverage.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The surcharge imposed by the City of Sherwood for Sanitary and Storm Utility service as indicated in Exhibit B is hereby adopted.

Section 2: Parts A & B of the Sanitary, Storm Rates and Street Maintenance Fees in Section 7 of the City of Sherwood, Oregon Master Fees and Charges in Resolution 2008-043 (adopted June 17, 2008) is hereby repealed.

Section 3: The new rates established by this Resolution shall be effective in March 2009.

SECTION 7: UTILITY CHARGES FOR SERVICE

Sanitary, Storm Rates and Street Maintenance Fee

A) Sewer

(A \$5.75 per Equivalent Dwelling Unit surcharge for the City is incorporated in the monthly Sanitary fee)

- The monthly sewer utility user charge for property within the City and Served by Clean Water Services (CWS) of Washington County shall be established by CWS and adopted annually.

B) Storm

(A \$10.71 per Equivalent Dwelling Unit surcharge for the City is incorporated in the monthly storm fee)

- The monthly sewer utility user charge for property within the City and Served by Clean Water Services (CWS) of Washington County shall be established by CWS and adopted annually.

C) Street Maintenance Fee

The following fees shall be charged for the Street Utility fund of the City:

- Single Family Residential \$5 monthly
- Non – Residential \$10 monthly
- Commercial \$10 monthly
