



RESOLUTION 2010-030

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD A CONTRACT TO CONSTRUCT THE BROOKMAN AREA SANITARY SEWER DOWNSTREAM UPGRADE PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City solicited Bids based upon competitive bidding processes meeting the requirements of the City and State Contracting Rules; and

WHEREAS, the City received one (1) Bid that was publicly opened on July 1, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the City reviewed the Bid submitted by Nutter Corporation in the amount of \$449,639.22 and determined that the Bid was a Responsive Bid; and

WHEREAS, the low bid amount was significantly lower than the engineer's estimate, staff recommends establishing a contingency amount of 15% to cover unforeseen construction issues and differing site conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The contract for construction of the Brookman Area Sanitary Sewer Downstream Upgrade is awarded to Nutter Corporation. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Nutter Corporation for a maximum of \$449,639.22 to complete this project.

Section 2: Subject to the limitations of the City and State Contracting Rules and other applicable laws, the City Manager is authorized to enter into change orders with Nutter Corporation for an amount not to exceed the contingency amount equal to \$67,446.00 (15% of bid).

Section 3: This Resolution shall be in effect upon its approval and adoption.
