



RESOLUTION 2010-043

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PORTLAND HABILITATION CENTER NORTHWEST, INC. FOR PROFESSIONAL CUSTODIAL SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF SHERWOOD

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood has a need for professional custodial services; and

WHEREAS, State law requires that the City use a Qualified Rehabilitation Facility (QRF) for custodial services; and

WHEREAS, the City chose not to renew the custodial agreement with Tualatin Valley Workshop and began negotiations with Portland Habilitation Center Northwest, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the contract with Portland Habilitation Center Northwest, Inc. is \$75,605.64/annually; a savings of \$6,191.64 from last year's contract with Tualatin Valley Workshop, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Portland Habilitation Center Northwest, Inc. for professional custodial services.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
