RESOLUTION 2010-051

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ALLOCATE FUNDS TO COMPLETE THE DESIGN AND LAND USE APPLICATION PROCESS FOR THE SHERWOOD SKATE PARK

WHEREAS, recommendation 1.4 of the 2006 Sherwood Park Master Plan is the design and construction of a Skate Park; and

WHEREAS, resolution 2009-070 authorized staff to engage a consultant to assist in the evaluation and feasibility of locating a Skate Park in Sherwood; and

WHEREAS, resolution 2010-016 authorized funds for the design of the Skate Park that is to be located at the Sherwood YMCA; and

WHEREAS, as part of the conceptual design process three design workshops were held and the community was invited to provide feedback and participate in the design process; and

WHEREAS, the next step in the process is to complete design and land use application process for the Skate Park; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost to complete the design and land use application process is \$38,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to allocate an amount not to exceed \$38,000 to complete the design and land use application process for the Skate Park.

Section 2. This resolution is effective upon its adoption by the City Council.
