



RESOLUTION 2011-050

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD A CONTRACT TO CONSTRUCT THE BROOKMAN AREA SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION – PHASE 1 PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City solicited Bids based upon competitive bidding processes meeting the requirements of the City and State Contracting Rules; and

WHEREAS, the City received eight Bids that were publicly opened on June 6, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the City reviewed the Bids and selected the lowest Responsive Bid submitted by Varin Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$762,424.40; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends establishing a contingency amount of 15% to cover unforeseen construction issues and differing site conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The contract for construction of the Brookman Area Sanitary Sewer Extension – Phase 1 is awarded to Varin Construction, Inc. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a contract with Varin Construction, Inc. for a maximum of \$762,424.40 to complete this project.

Section 2: Subject to the limitations of the City and State Contracting Rules and other applicable laws, the City Manager is authorized to enter into change orders with Varin Construction, Inc. for an amount not to exceed the contingency amount equal to \$114,363.66 (15% of bid).

Section 3: This Resolution shall be in effect upon its approval and adoption.
