



RESOLUTION 2015-060

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BLACKLINE INC. FOR THE 2015 SLURRY SEAL PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood has a responsibility to maintain the City's infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, Sherwood partnered with the City of Hillsboro to include Sherwood's 2015 Slurry Seal program in their RFP for the same services; and

WHEREAS, the RFP process identified Blackline, Inc. as the lowest responsible bidder.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Blackline, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$122,541.98 Inc. the 2015 Slurry Seal Program.

Section 2. Subject to the limitations of local and state contracting rules, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute contract change orders for a total amount not-to-exceed 10% of the original award (\$111,401.80).

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
