



RESOLUTION 2015-071

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE WASHINGTON COUNTY PUBLIC SAFETY LEVY, BALLOT MEASURE 34-236

WHEREAS, the Washington County Public Safety Levy was created in 2000, to serve all the residents of Washington County with public safety services, including special enforcement teams, prosecutors, juvenile councilors, probation and parole services, emergency communications shelters and, emergency shelters for victims of domestic violence and a mental health response teams; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of City of Sherwood and the surrounding area benefit from this service by having access to these services and these services could be at risk of being reduced or eliminated; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wants to express its support of Ballot Measure 34-236 and call upon the members of the Sherwood Community to do the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and the City Council support the passage of the Washington County Public Safety Levy, Measure 34-236 on November 3rd, 2015 ballot.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
