

RESOLUTION 2017-025

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE SW WILLOW COURT ROADWAY REPAIR PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City experienced a water main break in the Fall of 2016 that lifted approximately 400 lineal feet of roadway on SW Willow Court; and

WHEREAS, the City completed the design and produced bid documents to solicit contractors using a competitive bidding process meeting the requirements of local and state contracting statutes and rules (ORS 279C, OAR 137-049); and

WHEREAS, City Council has approved a budget transfer (Resolution 2017-007) to cover the cost of this unanticipated repair within the FY2016-17 budget; and

WHEREAS, Knife River Corporation - Northwest was the only responsive bidder for this project; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends City Council to authorize the City Manager to execute a construction contract with Knife River Corporation – Northwest in a Base Contract Amount of \$74,212 with Construction Contingency of \$18,553 (25%) of the Base Contract Amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- <u>Section 1:</u> The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract with Knife River Corporation Northwest in a Base Contract Amount of \$74,212 with Construction Contingency of \$18,553 (25%) of the Base Contract Amount for the repair of SW Willow Court.
- **Section 2:** This Resolution shall be in effect upon its approval and adoption.
