

RESOLUTION 2017-072

AUTHORIZING STAFF TO APPLY FOR A WASHINGTON COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT

WHEREAS, Washington County is currently accepting applications for the FY2018-19 Community Development Block Grant program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sherwood desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of improving the Marjorie Stewart Senior Center; and

WHEREAS, the 2011 Marjorie Stewart Senior Center Feasibility Study identified potential improvements to the facility; and

WHEREAS, the City applied for and received funds in prior cycles to complete portions of the improvements identified in the study; however funds were not available to complete all desired improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified improvements to the floors in the dining area, new appliances in the kitchen and a new folding panel room divider are necessary and would meet the goals of the CDBG funding program; and

WHEREAS the City hereby certifies that should the project be selected, the City will provide \$15,000 of inkind services to go towards the project; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated project cost is approximately \$123,000 and the City intends to apply for a CDBG Block Grant in the amount of \$108,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Staff is authorized to apply for a Washington County Community Development Block Grant for improvements to the Marjorie Stewart Senior Center.

<u>Section 2.</u> This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
