



RESOLUTION 2018-026

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE 2018 PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the City has identified the storm sewer on SW Merryman Street to be deficient and in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified the pavement on SW Merryman Street, SW Nottingham Court, SW Quiver Court, SW Willamette Street, SW Upper Roy Street and SW Tualatin Street to be deficient and in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, the City completed the design and produced bid documents to solicit contractors using a competitive bidding process meeting the requirements of local and state contracting statutes and rules (ORS 279C, OAR 137-049); and

WHEREAS, the City opened bids on March 22, 2018 and issued the Notice of Intent to Award with the mandatory seven (7) day protest period which is currently in process; and

WHEREAS, the City has budgeted the construction cost of this project within the FY2017-18 budget; and

WHEREAS, S-2 Contractors has been identified by city staff as the lowest responsive bidder; and


WHEREAS, City staff recommends City Council to authorize the City Manager to execute a construction contract with the lowest responsive bidder from the March 22, 2018 bid opening (S-2 Contractors) in a Base Contract Amount of \$898,283 with Construction Contingency of \$134,742.45 (15%) of the Base Contract Amount for the 2018 Pavement Rehabilitation Projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract upon the completion of the seven (7) day protest period with the lowest responsive bidder (S-2 Contractors) in a Base Contract Amount of \$898,283 with Construction Contingency of \$134,742.45 (15%) of the Base Contract Amount for the 2018 Pavement Rehabilitation Projects.

Section 2: This Resolution shall be in effect upon its approval and adoption.
