

RESOLUTION 2018-081

AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH MURRAYSMITH TO COMPLETE THE CITY'S WATER SYSTEM SEISMIC RESILIENCY PLAN

WHEREAS, the City updated the Water System Master Plan in May 2015 and identified that a Seismic Resiliency Plan needed to be completed; and

WHEREAS, OAR Chapter 333, Division 061 outlines the seismic vulnerability criteria that is to be incorporated into the overall capital improvement project planning and asset priorities for water systems; and

WHEREAS, OAR 333-061-0060 (5)(a) requires water systems to complete a seismic risk assessment and mitigation plan as part of the existing requirement for five-year updates to water system master plans; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2017-024 authorized the City Manager to enter into a contract with Murraysmith for the City's On-Call Engineering Services for the City's Municipal Water System; and

WHEREAS, City staff has negotiated a contract with Murraysmith to complete the study and assist with updating our Vulnerability Assessment.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF SHERWOOD RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Murraysmith to complete the City's Water System Seismic Resiliency Plan in the amount of \$158,790.
- **Section 2.** This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval and adoption.
