The Majority recommended that the Stearns industrial site be redesignated.

Mr. List stated that he protests any light industrial designations down town.

Mr. List and Mr. Sanders recommended that Neighborhood Commerical areas be struck from the map but left as a policy designation with the condition that market strength can be justified. List and Sanders were in favor. Galbreath opposed.

The majority recommended to change the six corners Neighborhood Commerical site to Community Commerical designation.
