October 19, 1976

Members had been given the codes from the State of Oregon on Mobile Home Parks at the last meeting. After discussing this it was decided that it would cover the needs of Sherwood pretty well. Wayne Bender moved and Elenora Jeffers seconded that they have Derryck Dittman review the mobile home park standards and report back to the Planning Commission his findings before they make up an ordinance on that zoning. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
