and on motion was laid over
for third reading at next meeting.

Ordinance No 3 prohibiting the
discharge of firearms inside the
corporate limits was introduced
by Mr. Elr and read before the
Council and on motion was
laid over for second reading
at next meeting.

An Ordinance, was introduced
by Mr. Elser to Tax the owners of
dogs residing inside the corporation
was read for the first reading and
on motion it was laid over for
second reading at next meeting
