

Ordinance No. 36

Sec 1 The people of the Town of Sherwood do Ordain as follows

That all Ladders, Ladders, Ropes, Hose, Wrenches, Axes, Hose cut pump, Buckets, fire hooks and all other fire apparatus shall be kept on the Town property and in the Town Hall and that to be loaned out or used for private use by any one except in case of fire, provided the fire company may have the right to use the apparatus for practice drill

Sec 2 Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of any article of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof they shall be fined not less than Two (\$2.00) Dollars nor more than Five (\$5.00) Dollars and in default of the payment of such fine they shall be imprisoned in the Town Jail not to exceed Two and one-half (2 1/2) Days
