

Ordinance No 37

The people of the Town of Sherwood do ordain as follows

sect 1 That any person or persons wishing to conduct a dance or ball in any Hall or other building within the corporate limits of Sherwood Oregon other than a private residence shall before the opening or commencing of ~~any~~ dance or ball procure from the then acting Marshal of the Town of Sherwood Oregon or his deputy a license or permit to run and conduct such dance or ball for which the person or persons wishing to conduct such dance or ball shall pay to said Marshal or Deputy a fee as follows

If such dance or ball is to run later than one (1) o'clock A.M. of the following morning or day the fee shall be \$1.75 & one $\frac{75}{100}$ dollar and if to close before one (1) o'clock the fee for such permit shall be one \$1.00 dollar

sect 2 Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of Sect 1 of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty

of a Misdemeanor and upon
 Conviction there of they shall
 be fined in any sum not
 less than \$5⁰⁰ nor more than
 \$20⁰⁰

Sec 3 It is hereby made the duty
 of the Town Marshal to attend
 either in person or by deputy
 all such dances or balls
 so licensed by him and to
 see that good order is kept
 in and around such building
 where such dance or ball is
 being conducted and to arrest
 any person or persons guilty
 of misconduct in violation
 of any town ordinance of
 the Town of Sherwood Oregon
 and for his services as night
 police at any such dance
 or ball the marshal shall
 receive and return all all
 such money collected by him
 for such license or permit
 in addition to any fees he may earn
 for the arrest of any person or
 persons guilty of a violation
 of any town ordinance of the
 Town of Sherwood Oregon
