

Ordinance No 42

The People of the Town of Sherwood Do Ordain as Follows

Section 1.

that from and after the adoption of this Ordinance and its approval by the President of the common council it is hereby designated and made the duty of the Marshal to act as street commissioner within the corporate limits of the town of Sherwood.

Section 2.

He shall attend the regular meetings of the common council or any special meetings when requested to do so by a written notice. He shall keep himself thoroughly informed of the conditions of all streets, highways, alleys, bridges, sewers and public grounds of the town and promptly report to the common council when to his knowledge any needed repairs or improvements is required together with the best manner of doing same. And in case any bridge sidewalk or crosswalk by reason of broken planks or timbers or otherwise is rendered dangerous for travel he shall immediately make such repairs as will at the least expense secure the public safety reporting the same to the common council at the next meeting following.

Section 3.

He shall also be authorized to grant permits for laying of sidewalks and improving streets, conditioned as required by the ordinances of the town and when occasion demands it issue permits for the temporary use of the sidewalk and street for building material, provided such permit shall only include that portion of the street in front of the lot upon which a building is being erected or repaired and in no case extend beyond the middle of such street.

Section 4.

He shall oversee all work authorized performed on the streets by the common council and shall see that no obstructions are allowed to remain upon the streets within the corporate limits he shall cause the removal of all nuisances from the streets and public grounds of the town and all necessary expense of such removal shall be paid by the town to be recovered as soon as possible from the person causing or permitting such nuisance he shall also see that all ordinances relating to streets crosswalks sidewalks alleys bridges sewers and ect . are strictly enforced and make complaint before the Recorder for all violations of the same .

Section 5.

While performing such duty as street commissnor the marshal shall receive for his services the customary wages paid for ordinary labor at such time .
