Ordinance No 42

The People of the Town of Sherwood Do Ordain at Follows
Section I.

that from and after the adoption of this Ordinance and its approval by the President of the common council it is hereby designated and made the duty of the Marshal to act as street commissinor within the corporate limits of the town of Sherwood.

Section 2.

He shallnattend the regular meetings of the common councilor any special meetings when requested to do so by a written notice. He shall keep himself theroughly informed of the anditions of all streets. highways. alleys. bridges.sewers a public grounds of the town and promptly report to the sommon council when to his knowledge any needed repairs or improvements is required togather with the best manner of doing same. And in case any bridge sidewalk or croswalk by reason of broken planksor timbers or otherwise is rendered dangerous for travel he shall immediately make such repairs as will at the least expense secure the public safty reporting the same to the common council at the next

Section 3.

de what is also authorized to grant permits for laying of sidewalks and improving streets, conditioned as required by the ordinances of the town and when occasion demands it

or building material. provided such permit shall only include that pertion of the street in front of the lot upon thich a building is being erected or repaired and in no case, beyond the middle of such street.

He shall eversee all work authorrized preformed on the streets by the common council and shall see that no

structions are allowed to remain upon the streets within the corporate limits he shall cause the removal of all nuisances from the streets and public grounds of the town and all neccesary expense of such removal shall be paid by the town to be recovered as soon as possible from the person causeing or permitting such nusiance he shall also see that all ordinances relating to streets crosswalkssidewalks alleys bridges sewers and ect. are strictly enforced and make complaint be fore the Recorder for all violations of the same

Section 5.

While preferming such duty as street commissner the marshal shall recieve for his swrvices the customary wages paid for ordinary labor at such time.
