

O R D I N A N C E N O 4 3 .

That from and after the adoption and its approval by the president of the common council it shall be unlawful for any person or persons owning or keeping any chickens ducks ^{geese}

turkeys or poultry of any kind to allow or suffer the same to run at large within the corporate limits of the Town of Sherwood Oregon.

Section No 2.

That any person or persons, violating any of the provisions of Sec. one of this ordinance and upon being convicted of the same before the town Recorder shall be liable to a fine in any sum not less than \$4.00 nor more than \$10 and in default of the payment of such fine they shall be imprisoned in the town jail not less than 2 days nor more than 5 days .

Section 3.

No prosecution shall be commenced to recover the penalties named in section 2 of this ordinance until at least the

owner or owners having charge of such poultry has been duly notified and if such owner or owners then fail to take up and keep in custody such poultry it shall be the duty of the town marshal to take up or cause to be taken up any and all poultry that may be running at large as mentioned in section one of this ordinance and impound in a secure inclosure provided therefor within the town limits and he shall then at once notify the owner if known if not known by posting notices in at least three public places within the town limits and if the owner does not appear and claim his property and pay all charges for taking up and advertising and keeping the same within three days from date of such notice the Marshal shall proceed at once to sell the poultry which he may have in his custody and all moneys derived from such sale shall be his fee in said case
