

Section 1.

The Town Marshal shall exercise a vigilant care over the peace and quiet of the Town . and see that all Ordinances rules and regulations of the Town is strictly observed and enforced . He take charge of the Council Chamber and keep the same in order . and before the sitting of any Council meeting have the room properly furnished with lights and fire? He must attend regularly upon the meetings of the Common Council and sittings of the Recorders Court unless excused upon good and sufficient cause.

Section 2

Before entering upon the duties of his office the Town Marshal shall give a bond with two good and sufficient surities in the sum of five hundred (\$500) Dollars to be approved by the Town Council for the faithful performance of his duties and that he will pay over all moneys that may come into his hands

Section 3.

The Town Marshal shall be entitled to the same fees as are now or may be provided by law for constables in this County and when said fees does not aggregate the sum of Ten (\$10) dollars in any one month as evidenced by Recorders docket entry the town Council at the first stated meeting following shall procede to draw a warrant on the town Treasurer for the deficiency

Section 4.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force after passage by the council and approved by the President
