AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE CONSTRUCTION OF BUILDINGS
IN BLOCKS 1, 2, and 3.

The People of the Town of Sherwood do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That no person, firm or corporation shall build or construct, or cause to be built or constructed, any building, shed or lean-to, for any purpose whatsoever, within the limits of Blocks 1, 2, and 3, of the Town of Sherwood, unless the walls of said building, shed or lean-to shall be built or constructed of stone, brick, cement blocks or concrete construction or other fireproof material.

Section 2. PROVIDED HOWEVER, That if any person, firm or corporation submit any plan, plans or specifications to the Council of the Town of Sherwood, for any building, shed or lean-to, to be erected or built of wood within Blocks 1, 2, and 3, the same to be veneered on the outside with either stone, brick, concrete, cement, sheet metal, or other fireproof material of sufficient thickness, the Council, may, upon approval of said plans or specifications, issue a permit allowing said building to be built or constructed according to the plans or specifications submitted.
