ORDINANCE NO. 13

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE TAXING AND KILLING OF DOGS.

The People of the Town of Sherwood do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to keep a dog or dogs within the corporate limits of the Town of Sherwood of the age of more than six months, unless the owner or keeper of such dog or dogs shall procure from the City Treasurer, a license for each dog, as in this ordinance provided.

Section 2. The owner, or persons having in charge, any dog or dogs, kept or owned within the corporate limits of the Town of Sherwood, shall, on or before the first day of January of each year, pay to the Town Treasurer the sum of \$3.00 for each and every male dog and the sum of \$5.00 for each and every female dog so owned or kept by him. Upon the payment of said sum or sums, the owner or keeper of said dog or dogs shall be entitled to a receipt from said treasurer, designating the owner's name and the number of the license, and a license tag bearing the same number as said receipt.

Section 3. If said license shall not be paid within 30 days after it has become due, it shall be the duty of the Town

Marshall, and he is hereby authorized to seize or kill any and all dogs found upon any street, alley-way, byway, or open yard without said license attached to the collar of said dog or dogs.
