AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING KEEPERS OF SALOONS, BARROONS OR DRINKING
SHOPS TO FURNISH AN INDEMNITY BOND.

The People of the Town of Sherwood do Ordain as Follows:

That any person, firm or corporation who shall be granted a license to conduct any saloon, barroom or drinking shop, within the corporate limits of the Town of Sherwood, shall, at the time such license be issued, furnish a good and sufficient indemnity bond signed by two well known free-holders, or in lieu thereof, a regular surety or indemnity company licensed to transact and solicit business within the State of Oregon. Said bond shall be made payable to the Town of Sherwood to indemnify and save harmless the said Town of Sherwood from and against any and all claims and damages arising from any act or acts by any person or persons while within said saloon, barroom or drinking shop.
