ORDINANCE NO. 21

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PEDDLERS AND CANVASERS WITHOUT OBTAINING A PERMIT OR LICENSE.

The People of the Town of Sherwood do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to sell, or offer for sale, any article of merchandise from a stand or wagon on any street or public ground within the limits of the Town of Sherwood, without first paying a license fee of \$ 10⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars per day and obtaining a permit in writing signed by both the Mayor and Marshall of said Town. The Mayor shall have power to refuse to sign or grant said permit without assigning any reason therefore.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to canvas for or to peddle any article of merchandise or to solicit subscriptions for any magazine, paper or publication, from house to house, or upon the streets or any public ground, without first obtaining a permit in writing signed by the Mayor and Marshall of said Town.

The Mayor shall have power to refuse to sign or grant said permit without assigning any reason therefore.

(PENALTY)

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before the town court be punished by a fine not to exceed \$ 25⁰⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars.
