

ORDINANCE No. 28

AN ORDINANCE ESTIMATING THE TAX LEVY FOR ENSUING YEAR  
THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SHERWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1

That the Common Council does, by this ordinance, hereby estimate and declare the estimate of expenditures for operating the TOWN of SHERWOOD for the ensuing year, to be \$1398.44.

SECTION 11

That the purpose for which the money to be raised by this levy is shown by the following budget which is hereby made a part of this ordinance:

SECTION 111

That in order to raise a sufficient sum to meet expenditures as shown by foregoing budget, it is hereby ordered that a ten mill general fund tax on all property both real and personal, which is taxable by law for state and county purposes, be levied.
