AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION FOUR(4) OF ORDINANCE NO. TWENTY-FOUR(24)
PERTAINING TO LICENSING BUSINESS AND CERTAIN EMPLOYMENTS:

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SHERWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

That Section Four(4) of Ordinance No. Twenty-four(24) pertaining to
licensing pool and billiard halls is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2 .

Any person, firm, company, or corporation who shall maintain
and conduct what is commonly known as a pool hall or a billiard hall
within the town of Sherwood shall pay a license according to the num-
ber of pool or billiard tables belonging to or used in the building or
place to be licensed.

For each and every table contained in said pool or billiard hall
the keeper thereof shall pay an annual license fee of Ten Dollars
(10.00), payable quarterly in advance.

Every place where pool or billiards is played when a charge is
made by the owner or the proprietor thereof to persons playing pool or
billiards shall be regarded as under this ordinance as a pool or
billiard hall.

Section 3.

That Section Four(4) of Ordinance Twenty-four(24) as originally
written seems to be unjust and does not subserve the interests of all
concerned, it is hereby declared that an emergency exists, and that
this ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its pas-
sage by the Common Council and its approval by the President.

Passed by the Common Council of the town of Sherwood, Oregon, on
the 10th day of January, 1916.
