

ORDINANCE NO. 31

AN ORDINANCE ESTIMATING THE TAX LEVY FOR THE ENSUEING YEAR

THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF SHERWOOD DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

S E C T I O N 1

That the Common Council of the Town of Sherwood, Wasginton County, Oregon, does by this ordinance hereby estimate and declare the estimate of expenditures for operating the Town of Sherwood for the year 1917 to be \$1398.00.

SECTION 11

That the purposes for which the money to be raised by this levy is shown by the following budget which is hereby made a part of this ordinance:

Fuel and Upkeep for Town Hall	\$ 5.00
Expenses of Recorder's Office	25.00
Elections - - - - -	25.00
Treasurer's Commission- - - -	35.00
Marshal's Salary! - - - - -	120.00
Interest on Outstanding War'nts	120.00
Electric Lights <sup>ca</sup> - - - - -	405.00
Miscellaneous streets, cross-walks, bridges and so forth	663.00

SECTION III

That in order to raise a sufficient fund to meet expenditures as shown by the foregoing budget it is hereby ordered that a ten mill general fund tax on all property, both real and personal, whihh is taxable by law for state and county purposes, be levied.
